The **Austrian National Committee** of the **ICTMD - International Council for Traditional Music (UNESCO/NGO)** invites you to the **Early Career Workshop in Ethnomusicology 2024**.

After two successful editions of this series in Germany, this time the workshop will take place in Austria, at the **Department of Musicology** of the **University of Vienna**.

We offer a space for exchange and support in which theses, term papers, projects and dissertations in the field of ethnomusicology can be presented and discussed in the group.

By doing so, we want to promote the exchange of young ethnomusicological research. Your contributions do not have to be completed theses or finished projects: Ongoing and planned research projects, collections of ideas or brainstormings are equally welcome.

The workshop is intended as a place for discussion of content and methods, a forum for constructive (peer) feedback and a "brave space" for the exchange of personal experiences.

In addition to the mutual presentation and discussion of your contributions, we would like to offer a practice-oriented workshop unit. This might include exercises on academic writing or presenting, information on funding and publishing or methods and tips for your own teaching. In this regard, please send us your preferences and other suggestions with your application so that we can make a selection according to your needs.

You can expect:

- Getting to know each other and exchanging personal research experiences,
- Presentations of individual research projects and discussion of these in a small group,
- Networking with other young ethnomusicologists,
- The opportunity to help organize future workshops.

Please send a short description of your work, project or intention (**in German or English**, approx. 1 page) including topic, research question, method, structure and work status to ictmd-nachwuchs@gmx.net by 31st of May 2024. You can also participate without giving a presentation; in this case send us a short letter of motivation, also by 31st of May 2024. We are currently trying to raise money as support for travel expenses, but we cannot guarantee any subsidies.

Participation in the workshop is free of charge. ICTMD membership is not required, but can be applied for at the workshop if you are interested.
